Please be aware with the next revision of the catalog the MA32 series will consolidate with the MA5, MA6 and MAX series.
We manufacture acrylic coin and currency holders for the protection of coins, currency, medallions, tokens, gaming chips, discs, pictures and documents. We inventory acrylic holders for all denominations of U.S. Coins, currency, and some foreign coins.

Capital® Coin \& Currency Holders are available through your authorized distributor or dealer. Please contact Capital® Plastics direct when your area authorized distributor is unable to service your needs.

ACRYLIC HOLDERS WITH SCREWS: Our three plate holders with screws are made for the collector who desires a distinctive environment for his or her possessions. Holders are made from high quality acrylic which will not fade or discolor. Our acrylics do not contain any sulfur, acid, polyvinyl chloride or oily substances. These holders consist of three plates; one colored center with coin openings and two outer clear plates called windows. Coins can be viewed from both sides of holders. Our currency holders are made of two clear acrylic plates securely held together by plastic screws.

INJECTION MOLDED HOLDERS: These holders have a snap together case with an acrylic center plate with coin openings. Colors are available. Coins can be viewed from both sides of holders.

COIN OPENINGS: We take great pride in sizing our coin openings to ensure an accurate fit of most coins. Each coin holder is tested in house with our coins. Our special tapered coin openings ensure a snug fit and grip the coin by a single edge only. When inserting your coins, be sure you insert coins from the front side of the center plate. All coins vary in size slightly, $+/-.003$ " in diameter, due to machine tolerances during the minting process. Pre-1900 U.S. Coins, Foreign Coins, and Morgan Dollars vary greatly in size. When ordering holders for these coins, we ask you send the exact measurements of your specific coins to us when ordering; to the thousandth of an inch (1.598") or the tenth of a millimeter ( 40.6 mm ), this ensures a proper fit of your coins.


CATALOG NUMBERS AND PRINTING: All our holders numbered in the BVD, 400's, GX \& MA series are fully imprinted with Titles, Dates, Mint Marks and any other appropriate descriptions. The BVD stands for Bank Vault Drawer. The BVD holders are 8"x14" and will fit in most safety deposit boxes. They are designed to hold complete sets or as many coins in a set as is aesthetically possible. Our 8 "x10" and smaller sized holders will also fit into safety deposit boxes. The 51 series is considered a stock book for coins. The holder is printed with a title and nothing else. You can make your own collection with these holders. The GA series are stand up coin displays that may have room to display a picture or document. The GB, MB, and C cases have chipboard inserts which are imprinted. The snap together cases are: Galaxy, 6.5"x6.5", Meteor, 4"x7", Comet, 4.25"x6.375", Vest Pocket, 3.3"x3.3", CAPS, 2"x3", Krown 2.5"x2.5", Round Disc,1.830", KF series 2.5"x2.5".

## The CD coin holder.

The CD holder is a round clear plastic case that snaps together. It's outside diameter is 1.830 ". The catalog numbers $D, E, F, G, H$, and I have a center ring of inert white soft plastic called Volara. Volara is used by the U.S. Mint. The CD's are not printed. The CD holders are packaged in bags of three or in boxes of twenty of the same denomination. The standard coin openings for the CD coin holders are as follows:

## The KF coin holder.

The KF holder is a square heavy clear plastic case that snaps together. The KF case is $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$. The KF case closes around a center part of inert white soft plastic called Volara. Volara is used by the U.S. Mint. The KF's are not printed. The KF holders are packaged in bags of three and in boxes of fifteen of the same denomination. The standard coin openings for the KF coin holders are as follows:

## Coin Fitting Tool

Because all coins vary in size somewhat, we have available for your use, a coin fitting tool which will permit you to increase the size of the coin opening. If the coin opening is too small, use one of our triangular coin fitting tools to scrape a small amount of acrylic out of the inside of the opening. Please do not attempt to file or cut the opening. If the opening is too large, use a thin, narrow strip of clear Mylar or acetate as a shim when placing the coin in the opening.
